Spar Lorry

We have been in negotiations with Spar to see if deliveries can be managed so as to not block the traffic. However, it does not seem possible to sort out a solution that is acceptable to everyone concerned, including all traders and the Council. Spar will try to ensure that deliveries are done as quickly as possible to minimise impact. We will still explore the possibility of a loading/unloading bay.

Hadlow Road Station

We have also been in discussion with the Ranger and Hadlow Station Garage about parking there. This has improved the situation for a short time and we will be monitoring it. We are also looking at getting a sign pointing to the village put up at the station.



Benches on the Green

The benches on the Green have been repaired, free of charge, by the Council, following a request from us.

Traffic Speeds

There has been a consultation about reducing traffic speed to 40mph in Damhead Lane, Hanns Hall Road and Benty Heath Lane. The deadline for the consultation has passed and we are now awaiting the outcome.
