Buses

The 22 bus service is returning to the village from 24th April. There will be an hourly service to Chester and Neston/West Kirby. The timetable will be available nearer the date. This service is unsubsidised so it is essential local residents use it or we could lose it again!



Play Area

The play area was closed for two weeks recently for the path to be tarmacked. This was funded by the Council.

Consultation on the second stage of the play area development has been completed and we are now pulling together the design and costs before looking at how to fund it. The additional pieces of equipment we are likely to put in, following the consultation, are a large climbing unit suitable for older children, a roundabout, a structure suitable for imaginative play such as a train or boat and road markings on the tarmac. It is likely to take a year before we have the funds to be able to make these improvements.

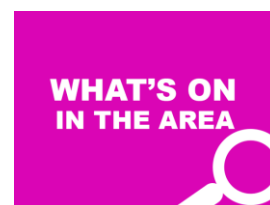
