Lorries in the village

Ann Dutton attended the meeting to raise concerns about traffic approaching the bend at Nag's head too quickly and in particular, the apparent increase in the number of lorries. We are going to seek a meeting with CWaC to discuss traffic issues in more detail, once the results of a traffic survey the Council is undertaking in May are available.

Station Master's House Action Group (SMHAG)

Joan Butcher attended the meeting to discuss the expression of interest that SMHAG had put into the Council for a Community Asset transfer of the Station Master's House to be run as a community building, rather than rented out commercially.



Parking Questionnaire

We have undertaken a questionnaire to understand more why people park on the village green and for how long. We will now be analysing the results of the survey before deciding whether to recommend to the Council that the number of hours that people can park on the Green is limited. Ultimately the Council will decide what steps to take if we do make a recommendation.

Hooton Road Service Station

An application for planning permission to build four houses on the current service station site has gone into the Council. We will respond welcoming this development, although advising that four houses is quite a large number for this site. In addition, we will express concern that any house building on this land should fit with the general street scene along Hooton Road.
