Parking Questionnaire

We have now analysed and had an initial discussion about the results of the survey that we did on who parks on the Green and for how long. Our initial view is that the data shows that parking is largely self-regulated. There are occasional problems but these are not persistent or consistent. We will be discussing this further before making a final decision at our next meeting whether to recommend to the Council that the number of hours that people can park on the Green is limited. Ultimately the Council will decide what steps to take if we do make a recommendation.

Changes at Willaston Surgery

Brigewater Healthcare NHS Foundation has given six months' notice of withdrawal from the contract to run the village surgery. The West Cheshire Clinical Commissioning Group is responsible for ensuring that a service continues to be provided should the tendering process for a new provider take longer than six months. The Patients' Participation Group will again be involved in the tendering process.

Footpaths

We have worked with the Council and the Community Payback Team to remove the nettles and brambles that border the pathway leading from Mill Green to the Recreation Ground, where the children walk on their way to school. We have taken advice and are doing our best to ensure that the area will remain natural and wildlife will not be affected.



Neston Waste Recycling Centre

Residents now need a permit for taking waste to Neston recycling centre which can be obtained by visiting www.cheshirewestandchester.gov.uk or by ringing 0300 123 7042. The opening times for the centre have also changed: Monday 8am-4pm; Tuesday and Wednesday closed; Thursday and Friday 10am to 6pm; Saturday and Sunday 9am to 5pm. The gates appear to shut approximately ten minutes before the closing time.
