Summary of 2017 AGM

Our AGM was held on 29th September. Approximately 67 people attended and heard about the work that we had done over the year. This included:

- Pursuing effective disabled access to Martins/Post Office;
- Development of phase two of the play area improvements;
- Car parking survey on the Green;
- Installation of a raised platform on FP32 (behind Pollards to the Wirral Way);
- Discussions of various traffic issues with the Principal Engineer from CWaC;
- Correspondence with the British Legion following the closure of the building;
- Running a successful website, Facebook pages and publication of two newsletters;
- Responding to a range of planning applications.

We are pleased to welcome Sandra Kettiros onto the committee as a new Resident Representative.

Issues raised by residents included:

- Traffic, particularly around the zig-zag at Nag's Head. We will be looking into options proposed.
- Planning permissions for stables on Green Belt land;
- Flooding of drains near the bus stop opposite the Green. We will follow this up.
