Traffic Issues

Following comments from residents about lorries going through the village, we have been in contact with Aldi and they have agreed to ask their drivers and suppliers not to use the B5133. Since then, committee members felt that we have seen a decrease in lorries. We will continue to monitor this and can contact Aldi about specific vehicles if we know their registration number and time they went through the village.



Following a further request from a resident we will also be writing to a local company about the large tractors that go through the village, asking that they re-iterate the speed limit.



Play Area

Working with CWaC, we will be installing a children's tractor and trailer and roundabout in the play area. In addition, there will be a short trail between items with some coloured blobs, stepping stones and a wobble board and some road signs on the tarmac path. The work takes place in mid-January.

Willaston District Community Plan

We reviewed the progress we have made on implementation of the plan. There has been good progress on many of the issues identified but some are not possible to achieve. A summary of the work we have done is available to be seen on our website.



Christmas Lights

The lights were refurbished for Christmas 2017 and will now be taken down. This will allow the tree to be trimmed. We have set up a working group to look into options for the lights in the future.
