# Key Issues from the meeting held on Monday 16th July 2018



### **Planning**

Several residents attended to express concern about an outline planning application to build houses on land adjacent to Cherry Brow Farm on Hadlow Road. The Residents' Society agreed to object to this outline application. However, the application has subsequently been withdrawn.

Another resident attended to discuss the revised application for the proposed development on the former Royal British Legion site by McCarthy and Stone, which the Residents' Society continues to object to. The revised application is likely to go to the Planning Committee in August or September 2018 when the elected Councillors will make the final decision.



#### **Pavements**

A resident also attended to express concern about a car on Neston Road that crashed into her garden wall, where the pavements are very narrow. Cllr Myles Hogg agreed to discuss this further with her, including any possible safety measures that could be implemented.



#### Willaston Christmas Lights

A positive start has been made to the funding campaign and several further events are being planned, including a raffle, quiz night and WI tea. The campaign has received good coverage by the press, including the Liverpool Echo and Radio Merseyside. A website for Willaston Christmas Lights and 'Go Fund Me' page are due to be launched on 13<sup>th</sup> August.

There will be regular updates on money raised that will be included on websites, notice boards, etc.

# World War One Commemoration Weekend

WR&CS is heading up a community group to plan a series of events over the weekend of 9-11<sup>th</sup> November 2018 to mark the centenary of the end of World War One.
