Play Area

WR&CS is working with the Council to identify options for a new large piece of equipment for the play area. Options will shortly be available for a village-wide consultation and fund-raising events are also being planned.

Welcome Pack

WR&CS is working with Hooton Residents' Association to put together a welcome pack for people buying houses on the new housing estate by Hooton Station. If you are aware of anyone moving to Willaston, please let us know as the Willaston churches have already developed a comprehensive welcome pack that we can arrange for them to receive.



Planning

WR&CS will be objecting to a planning application to build six houses on the site of Hanns Hall Livery as this includes building on Green Belt land. We have also objected to proposed alterations to the Station Master's House at Hadlow Road Station as they would have altered the view from the station platform and the proposed plans are inconsistent with the 1950s theme. We understand that McCarthy and Stone has put in an appeal for their application on the former British Legion site but this has not yet been processed by the Inspectorate.
