# Key Issues from the meeting held on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2019



### Play Area



We have been holding a village-wide consultation on what piece of equipment to put in the play area. The preferred item includes various climbing options, a net and a slide. The budget for buying and installing it is £30,853.50 and we will now start fundraising. Information about activities will be on the noticeboards, WR&CS website and Facebook and we will also approach trusts and other funding bodies for support.

There is a hole in the safety surface by the roundabout which has been reported to the Council and will be repaired.

### Post Office

McColls will be closing on 17<sup>th</sup> August which means that the village is likely to be without a Post Office. We have set up a sub-committee to look at what action (if any) can be taken to keep a Post Office facility in the village. Even if this is possible, it is however expected that there will be a period of time when there is no Post Office available after 17<sup>th</sup> August. We will update when we have more information.

This major bicycle race is coming to Wirral/Cheshire and will be passing through Willaston on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> September. This will mean that various roads in the area will be closed. Further details will be published when available.
