Waste and Recycling

The days for waste and recycling collections will shortly be changed. Keep an eye out for information about your collection. The new system for bins will come in 2022. This includes a large bin for recycling, rather than the boxes and the need to pay for a garden waste bin.

Planning

Michelle Swan had attended the previous meeting and asked that WR&CS develop a Neighbourhood Plan. This had been considered by WR&CS in 2019 but rejected as it is a considerable amount of work and requires identification of where development should take place, as well as where it should not. The Committee agreed at the September 2021 meeting that this is not something we should pursue.

Hooton Crematorium

Publication of a planning application for a crematorium in Hooton is expected shortly. The response will be led by Hooton Residents' Association but WR&CS agreed to support them with any planning objection as this is a major application on Green Belt land and could lead to further ribbon development on Hooton Road. The issue of traffic through our village is also a major concern. UPDATE: The planning application is now out and Residents are encouraged to submit comments.



Speed Restrictions

Following our request, the Council has agreed to do speed assessments in Hooton Road and Hadlow Road. However, they will only implement a 20mph zone if the average speed is below 24mph.
