Key Issues from the meeting held on Mon. 11th March 2024



#### The future of WR&CS

Organisation Leads gave their groups' feedback. The Vice Chair then read a statement: An Officers' meeting recently took place which again highlighted that although current officers encourage others to take on various vacant roles, or lead on specific projects, volunteers are not coming forward. This makes it extremely difficult for current Officers to be positive about the future. In addition & following legal guidance obtained during the data protection issue in 2023, current Officers feel unable to continue with the organisation as it currently stands.

The Vice Chair has confirmed that he will not seek re-election at the AGM & other Officers intend to resign. All Officers wish to emphasise that this is not their preferred choice but feel that they have been left with little option.

Looking forward, if another organisation was to be set up, this would still require WR&CS to cease operations for any new organisation/company to start afresh to protect against any historical issues.

As it currently stands & in accordance with the WR&CS Constitution, a Special General Meeting will be held for WR&CS to close; this has been arranged for Friday 20<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2024 in the Memorial Hall.

In the event of a closure, realised assets or protected funds remaining shall be distributed amongst those organisations existing within the district of Willaston. *This particularly affects the ownership & operation of the Christmas lights on the Green*. The WR&CS website & Facebook page would also cease to operate.

In the future, if a group of residents set up another organisation/company in whatever form, or explore a more formal organisation before a dissolution, they would be in the same situation, as assets remaining will still need to be distributed amongst organisations within the district of Willaston.

A meeting will now be organised ASAP for a pan-village discussion.

## **Planning Matters**

Brian G. again discussed the current position of WR&CS not having a Planning Officer in place. Barry V. has offered support to any interested parties re. how to formulate a planning report.

It seems that the new Green Belt Alliance is no longer in operation.

Fund-raising initiatives to purchase land off Hooton Road (the last remaining area dividing Willaston & Hooton) were discussed. It was clarified that WR&CS cannot engage in such purchases as we are an unincorporated organisation. This will remain an ongoing point of discussion.

#### Footpaths & Bridleways / Environmental Group update

No activity with Footpaths at the moment. Monthly litter picking sessions continue & upcoming SUNDAY dates are 17<sup>th</sup> March, 21<sup>st</sup> April, 19<sup>th</sup> May, 16<sup>th</sup> June, 21<sup>st</sup> July. All dates are displayed on the notice board.

#### Councillor's Report

- ✓ The Highways Dept. will repair the wall between Pollards & adjacent car park. No date has yet been confirmed for this to be completed.
- ✓ Double yellow lines (at the corner of Hooton Road/Overdale Road & at the Green/Hadlow Road) have been agreed by the Highways Dept. No completion date has been confirmed.
- ✓ CWaC will affix a Commemorative plaque on Johnston's recreation Ground to honour the Coronation of King Charles. No completion date has been confirmed.
- ✓ Four cherry trees were planted in Feb. at the corner of Meadow Lane, replacing 2 felled last year.

- ✓ The Post Office has introduced a new Drop & Collect parcel service which will operate from the Spar in Willaston from Wed. 3<sup>rd</sup> April.
- ✓ Operation 'Park Safe' has been rolled out across Cheshire Constabulary. Residents can now report illegal parking problems online via the website. Residents can upload videos/photos of offending vehicles where they will be assessed. Minor obstructions or issues will be allocated to the local PCSO or beat officer.
